COVID-19 Coronavirus Vaccinations

< 新型コロナウイルスワクチン接種について >

The temporary COVID-19 vaccination (free) program ended March 31, 2024.

Starting from April 2024, the program will change to offering vaccinations periodically (in the same manner as periodic vaccinations for seasonal influenza) based on the Immunization Act.

Information about vaccinations in fiscal year 2024 is indicated below, as of September 11.

Eligibility	(1) City residents who are 65 or older on the vaccination day (2) City residents who are 60 to 64 years old on the vaccination day, and have a serious heart, kidney, respiratory, or immune function disorder that can be verified by a physical disability certificate or other document
Period	October 1 (Tue) to March 31, 2025 (Mon) Note: To request a vaccination, contact a healthcare institution to schedule an appointment
Number of Vaccinations	One vaccination during the indicated period
Cost	Patient payment amount: 3,260 yen (not refundable after vaccination) [Members of Households Receiving Welfare Assistance] Free vaccination coupons will be mailed near the end of September [Members of Households with All Members Exempt from Paying Municipal Tax] Free vaccination coupons will be issued for applications received in advance. To apply, contact the local Health Promotion Center.
What to bring for a vaccination	(1) Vaccination coupon (2) Documentation that can verify level of disability (such as a physical disability certificate) For both (1) and (2): Proof of address and age (such as a My Number Card or a public health insurance card)

Q Can someone that is not indicated as eligible above receive a vaccination?
A Yes, others can be vaccinated if they pay the full amount out-of-pocket. Vaccination availability periods and costs may vary for respective healthcare providers.
